## Making it affordable:

Not all churches, or schools will be able to afford a class or draw enough people to fill a class. The following are ideas of how to make a class or workshop affordable in your church or school:

- Contract with me to teach the class and devise a small fee structure for participants to pay. Depending on the class and the community size this could be as low as \$5/person but rarely would it be more than \$25/person for a half day workshop.
- Consider working with another church or school in your community or in a near by community. Both advertise and host the class/workshop jointly at one location.
- Consider a half day or all day seminar instead of several 2-hour classes to keep the cost and travel fee lower in the long run. Contact Laura Murphy with the specific needs and we come up with a plan that works for your church or school.
